



McCartan Bookmakers Rules

McCartan Bookmakers reserves the right to change any of the published rules at any time without prior notification. It is the customer's responsibility to be fully aware of all the rules prior to placing a wager. These Rules Supersede Any Rules That May be Displayed on Shop Screens.

HORSE RACING

Ante-post prices are offered on most major horse racing events up to the overnight declaration stage (usually 10.30 am UK time on the day before the race). Ante-post bets are accepted on the basis of all in run or not, unless a "with a run" price is offered. Stakes are lost if an ante-post selection does not take part. No Tattersalls Rule 4 deductions are made to winning ante-post bets. Where weather or outside influences cause an event to be postponed or rescheduled to another day then ante-post bets will stand, provided that the entries are not re-opened. Ante-post bets on horse racing will be void if the race is officially abandoned or declared void, or the conditions of the race/venue is altered. Best Odds Guaranteed has a maximum bonus of £1000 for singles and £500 for Multiples with Max Stake of £500 Win or £250 EW.

Each-way betting - The following place terms apply on each-way bets unless specifically stated at the time of placing the bet: a) Handicaps with 16 or more runners: ¼ the odds for the first four places. b) Handicaps with 12 - 15 runners: ½ the odds for the first three places. c) All Races with 5 to 7 runners: ¼ the odds for the first two places. d) All non handicap races with 8 or more runners: 1/5 odds 1-2-3 e) All races with 2-4 runners - all place money goes on to win. Each-way bets are not permitted on unranked favourites, and if accepted in error, will be declared void. All Each Way Accumulator Bets (Doubles and Upwards) with selections of 3/1 or less or the SP favourite of the race is 6/4 or less that selection will revert to 1/6 the odds.

Withdrawals In all horse races, excluding ante-post bets, if a horse is withdrawn without coming under starters orders it is treated as a non-runner. A deduction may be made from the winnings of bets struck at a fixed price and, if there is insufficient time to form a new market, starting price. The deduction will be defined in accordance with Tattersalls Rule 4 (c), as shown in the following table. 3/10 or lower 75p, 2/5 to 1/3 70p, 8/15 to 4/9 65p 8/13 to 4/7 60p 4/5 to 4/6 55p 20/21 to 5/6 50p Evs to 6/5 45p, 5/4 to 6/4 40p 13/8 to 7/4 35p, 15/8 to 9/4 30p, 5/2 to 3/1 25p, 10/3 to 4/1 20p, 9/2 to 11/2 15p, 6/1 to 9/1 10p, 10/1 to 14/1 5p, 15/1 and higher no deduction. In the case of two or more horses being withdrawn then the total deduction shall not exceed 75p in the pound (Sterling). The exception being for Guaranteed Morning Prices in which case if there is a non runner the following terms apply. If the non runner is quoted at 8/1 or less the bet will revert to SP. If the non runner is quoted between 8/1 and 14/1 a rule 4 will apply as stated above and if the non runner is greater than 14/1 no rule 4 will apply.

Double engagement - A horse doubly engaged will be settled on the race in which it runs unless the specific time of the race is declared in which it will be declared as a non runner if it doesn't run in the specified race.

We Pay double result on all single bets on UK & Irish Racing. All multiple bets will be settled on first past the post only. Foreign Racing will be settled on Official Result in both Singles & multiples. In all cases, Official Result will apply where the race is declared void, the horse is placed first in error by the judge, the horse has taken the wrong course or when a horse falls to weigh in or carries the wrong weight.

Any Promotions e.g. free bets, matched bets will have a benefit limit of £500 unless stated otherwise. Free Stakes will not be refunded in any free bets or matched bets. Cashbacks as free bets will have a maximum refund of £50 unless otherwise stated.

SOCCER

1. Singles are accepted on the matches from the following leagues. English Premiership Spanish Primera Liga Italian Serie A German Bundesliga Singles are also accepted on any Cup game and all Internationals. They are also accepted on any game which is broadcast live on Television. If a game is included that is not from the above list, then the minimum stipulation will be a treble. The only exception to this rule, is that ANY team may be doubled with a live game, irrespective of which league they play in. Northern Irish league and FAI games are minimum trebles in all cases.

2. All soccer match bets apply to full 90 minutes play unless otherwise stated. This includes injury time but not extra time or penalty shoot-out. All bets will be accepted as 90 Minute Win betting unless stipulated otherwise. Respective of the prices written on the docket e.g. "Goals Galore" must be written on the docket for it to be accepted as such.

3. Bets are accepted up to kick off time. Any selection inadvertently taken where the kick off time was earlier than when the wager was accepted will be void. Should a match take place earlier than advertised the selection will be classed as a runner as long as the bet was placed on time for the new kick off.

4. Should a match be abandoned before 90 minutes play then all bets will be declared void unless the outcome of that bet has already been decided e.g. the first goal has been scored then First Goalscorer bets will be settled.

5. Bets placed on postponed matches will stand so long as the game is played within 24 hours of the original scheduled kick off time and the venue remains the same.

6. For multiple bets the maximum number of draws which can be included in any single line is five. The maximum number of correct scores in any single line is five. Should any more be accepted in error the bet will be settled on the first five selections on the receipt and the rest declared void.

7. First and last goal scorer bets and other specials such as bookings will be settled according to the UK Press Association.

8. A Bonus will be applied to 6 or more Winning English & Scottish Soccer teams taken from the 90 Minute Long List on the "Bonus Coupon". Bonus Applies to 90 Min win – draw – win Long list only & not any other markets e.g. Handicaps, Half Time, Goals Galore, Unders/Overs etc. One Bonus Payment Per Customer. 6 matches must complete the 90 mins for bonus to apply. The maximum stake is £100. Should a stake of greater than £100 be accepted the bonus will apply to the first £100 only irrespective of the amount of dockets the bet is written on. Original Stake not included in Bonus. Maximum Bonus Benefit is £500.

9. Whilst we try to ensure the accuracy of our sporting coupons we reserve the right to correct any obvious errors and we will settle any bets at the correct price. All Pairs on all sporting coupons are subject to fluctuation and bets will be settled at the till price at the time the bet has been placed.

10. Any special soccer promotions or cashbacks e.g. First Goalscorer Special will apply to singles only unless specified otherwise. There will be a maximum benefit of £200 per customer on any such promotion.

G.A.A

1. All bets will be settled on 60/70 minutes play respectively at the prices advertised. The term '60/70 minutes play' refers to the period of play including time added by the match officials for stoppages, but not scheduled extra time. Any subsequent enquiries into the match result or later match disqualification will be ignored for settlement of match bets which will be settled on that days match result.

2. Any match which is abandoned before the completion of the match i.e. 60/70 play will be void. This ruling does not apply to first goal scorer bets which will stand provided a goal has been scored prior to abandonment. Number of points/bets or number of goal bets will be void unless the maximum quote has been obtained at the time of abandonment in which case bets will stand. Additional rules as detailed under Football Rules will also apply to GAA events where applicable.

3. Extra time does not count unless otherwise stated.

4. Any match postponed to another day will be void.

5. If an accumulator is reduced by non-runners the bet will stand irrespective of the minimum requirements laid down in these rules.

6. Bets taken on First/Last goal scorer will be void if that player does not take part in the game or if he

comes on after the first goal is scored. Bets on last goal scorer will be void if that player does not take part in the game or does not come on as a substitute. In the event of a dispute over the award of a goal for First/Last goal scorer or scorer special purposes, settlement will be in accordance with the result given by GAA within 48 hours of the final whistle. Any subsequent changes to the result will be ignored for settlement purposes. Own goals do not count for settlement of first/last goal scorer bet.

7. Any match which is abandoned before completion of the match (i.e. 70 mins.) will be void unless an official result is declared by those teams' governing body within 24 hours of postponement, in which case that official result will govern win/draw/win settlement. All other markets will be void unless their result is already decided. When an abandoned match(es) reduces the clients bet to below the permitted minimum for a list the bet will stand, with the void match(es) treated as non-runners for settling purposes. This ruling does not apply to bets involving First Goal scorer which will stand provided a goal has been scored prior to abandonment. Bets on Last Goal scorer will be void in the event of abandonment.

GOLF

1. Where a golfer withdraws before the start of a tournament then all bets on that participant will be declared void provided that the bet was placed not more than two weeks prior to the official start of the event.

2. A player who tees off is deemed 'under orders' and all outright and 18 hole bets stand.

3. In 72 hole match bets where both players miss the cut then the lowest score after two rounds determines the winner.

4. When a tournament is reduced by weather or other outside influences then bets will be settled on the outright winner as long as eighteen holes have been played except where the tournament is played on a different course every day when all bets will be declared void.

5. If a player should, having teed off, withdraw during the tournament for whatever reason then he will be deemed to have finished last for betting purposes.

6. For three ball betting dead heat rules apply. A tie will be quoted for two ball betting and where a tie occurs all bets on players are losers.

7. For top player and tournament betting all bets will be settled on the player with the lowest score over 72 holes. Dead heat rules apply except for where the result is determined by a play-off.

8. For 72 hole match betting if a player withdraws before he has completed one round then all bets are declared void. If a player withdraws after one round then he is deemed the loser even if the other player misses the cut. If both players withdraw after one round then the lowest score is deemed the winner.

9. In the event of a player withdrawing before the start of a specified 2 BALL or 3 BALL: All bets on that 2+3 ball will be declared void. (If a player plays one shot of his 2 or 3 ball he is deemed as a runner).

BOXING

1. All boxing matches include the draw therefore bets on either boxer is a loss if a fight ends in a draw.

2. If any fighter fails to answer the bell at the beginning of a round, the fight is deemed to have finished in the previous round for the purposes of round by round betting.

3. All fights must take place at the scheduled date and venue to have action.

RUGBY (BOTH CODES)

1. A handicap tie price will be quoted and if the game is a draw on handicap, then all bets on sides will be losers.

2. All bets are settled on 80 minutes play. Extra time does not count for betting purposes unless otherwise stated.

3. Scratch prices are available on all major matches and include a draw price. Winning margin betting is from scratch.

4. Abandoned and postponed matches are deemed void for betting purpose unless they are replayed within one week.

5. Penalty tries will count for the purposes of time of first try bets. A price is quoted for penalty try in our first try scorer betting and, in this instance, bets on players will be losers.

SPECIAL OFFERS

Horse Racing Prices Guaranteed

Early & Board Prices are guaranteed, UK & Irish horse racing only. Max stake per customer: €/£500 win or €/£250 Each Way for Morning Prices taken 30 minutes prior to the advertised time of race or €/£100 win or €/£50 Each for board prices taken within 30 minutes of the advertised off time of the race. Does not apply to extra markets. Any Amount over these limits will be settled at the price taken when placing the bet. Max Benefit for guaranteed odds in all cases is £1000.

Lucky 15's, 31's & 63's

Treble/4X/5X the odds 1 winner

Applies to Horse Racing only. Does not apply to virtual events. Max Bonus £500.

SPECIALS & EXTRA MARKETS

Today's Specials & Pick 'N' Mix (First Off Double, Ruby Walsh Double, Hot Pot Accum etc.)

Specials cannot be coupled. Subject to fluctuation and subject to a Rule 4 deduction. Bets only accepted until 30 minutes prior to start of first selection in the special. If accepted within 30 minutes, then bet should be settled at SP. 'Jockey specials' stand irrespective of who actually rides the named selections in the special.

Across The Card Doubles & Nags and Mutts Doubles

Subject to fluctuation and subject to a Rule 4 deduction. If either selection becomes a non-runner, it will become a single bet at SP on the remaining selection.

Horse Racing Match Bets

Bets are settled on the best finishing position. Subject to fluctuation and subject to a Rule 4 deduction. In the event of neither horse finishing the course all bets are void. If one horse finishes the course and the other horse fails to complete the course all match bets stand on those 2 horses.

Favs vs The Field

Subject to fluctuation and subject to a Rule 4 deduction.

Winning distance / How far will it win by

Betting on the winning distance will be on races only as displayed. The winning distance will be that margin, as officially announced between the winning horse and the second. All winning distance bets are settled on a first past the post basis only, i.e. double result does not apply. In the event of a withdrawal resulting in a Rule 4 of 10c or greater in a race where we offer distance betting the Rule 4 amount will be split between the number of distance options. In the event of a selection being withdrawn the not to win price of the favourite will be subject to a reverse rule 4. E.g. 8/1 shot withdrawn, favourite Evens not to win. Reverse rule 4 of 10c applies. Fav not to win settled at 11/10

Betting without

Where we offer prices on an event without a nominated selection, for settlement purposes the finishing position of the 'without' selection will be ignored. Any each-way terms advertised are settled on the actual number of runners who take part in the race, excluding the 'without' selection. Subject to fluctuation and subject to a Rule 4 deduction.

Place Only betting

In the event of a horse being withdrawn, not under starter's orders, stakes on that selection will be returned. Bets for the remaining horses in the race will be subject to a deduction based on our place only price of the withdrawn horse(s) at the time of the withdrawal, (see Place Only Rule 4 Table below) e.g. Horse X priced at 1/1 in the place only -2 places market, then the rule 4 deduction of 30c based on the 1/1 place price shall apply to the 'place only' betting market. The number of places being paid shall remain constant e.g. If we are originally paying three places and the race is reduced to 7 or less runners we shall still pay 3 places. The only exception to this is when the number of runners is equal to or less than the number of places on offer. In this instance all bets are void. Normal dead-heat rules apply. Double Result concession does apply to this market.

Jockey number of winners

If the jockey rides any horse which, according to that days Racing Post he was not scheduled to ride, that ride does not count for the purposes of bets on that jockey.

SP Favourites Place Accumulators

Placepot rules apply. In the event of joint or co-favourites winning, the horse with the lowest race card number is the winner. Dead Heats count in full. Meeting Place Accumulators cannot be coupled.

Combined winning distances for a meeting

Distances for each race meeting are settled on a 'first past the post' basis. If any of the scheduled races at a meeting are not run, bets are void unless the maximum quote has been attained. The maximum winning distance per race for a flat race is 12 lengths while a National Hunt race is 30 lengths. This also applies should only one horse complete the race. Distances are as follows: Nose - 0.05 Short Head: 0.1 Head, 0.2 Neck: 0.3 Half a length: 0.5 3/4 of a length: 0.75 1 length: 1 Etc. No Finishers - If there are no finishers in a race, it shall be treated as void. Walkovers will be excluded from all markets unless created by the withdrawal of a horse after we have begun quoting a market concerning the race in question, in which case the make-ups will be as follows Distances: Flat 5 lengths, National Hunt 12 lengths.

Text Betting

Text Bets are subject to a Maximum payout limit of £10,000. Our text SMS console records the time your text was received by us and this time will be used as time of customer placement. Any bets received late according to this time will be void, win or lose. Confirmation receipts will be sent immediately after we confirm the bet in our EPOS system. If these conditions are met, Bets will stand irrespective of when you receive your confirmation message. For avoidance of doubt if you do not receive a confirmation text before the start of your chosen event it is the customers responsibility to phone us and confirm if a bet has been accepted. Any prices included in the text will be subject to our normal fluctuation rules. Price at time of bet being entered into system by staff will be given irrespective of price sent by customer. Text bets can not be used for in-play betting. If your account cannot cover the stake, and we receive no instructions to update your balance, the bet stake will be reduced to monies available. If no monies are available bet will be void win or lose. Text bets are only accepted during normal telephone opening hours. Any text with unclear instructions will be void. Once a bet is confirmed in our EPOS system it cannot be cancelled. We reserve the right to refuse all, or part, of any bet sent to us by text. All bets will be settled using McCartanBet normal betting rules and conditions as displayed to shops. It is the customers responsibility to ensure security of their account and we will not be liable to any loss that may occur due to misuse/fraud of your account.

MAXIMUM PAYOUTS:

It is the duty of all customers to stay within the limits mentioned hereafter. All bets are subject to a maximum payment to any one client in any one day irrespective of stakes, odds or number of winning lines as listed below. A bet is accepted on the basis that it is the investment of one client. Full service means where shows of betting, off-times and results are given by S.I.S for horse racing or greyhounds. The onus or responsibility rests firmly with the customer to ensure that he stays within the limits outlined below. We reserve the right to refuse payment on any bet which we can not verify on the security system of the days business or to void any bet when we are satisfied it is not bona fide. There is an overall maximum payout of £50,000 to any one In shop client on any time during office opening hours. Any bet settled after office hours will have a maximum payout of £25,000. All Phone and Text Bets will be subject to a Maximum Payout of £10,000 irrespective of In-Shop Limits.

Horses

We pay Double Result on all single horseracing selections in Ireland and the UK which are covered in full service by S.I.S. Double Result / First Past The Post bets are subject to a maximum payout of £50,000 (NB: Double Result applies only to singles and meetings covered by full SIS Service. Everything else is first past the post). The above limits apply even where a client has taken prices, and except in the following cases:

Any bet which includes a selection which is not covered in full service by SIS, or any bet which contains a selection involved in overseas racing is subject to a maximum payout of £10,000. Ante post bets are subject to maximum payout of £20,000.

All Accumulators in which Early Morning prices have been taken will have a limit of £20,000 to any one client on any one day. The Maximum Benefit on Best Odds Guaranteed is £1000 for singles and £500 for Multiples. The maximum Bonus on Lucky 15/31/63's is £500.

Placepots/Jackpots have a maximum payout of £10,000 except for those placed through totepool which has no limits. It is the customer's responsibility to ask staff in plenty of time to place bets through the totepool and if for any reason it is not placed the £10,000 limit will apply. Greyhounds

All Greyhound Bets are subject to Maximum Payout of £20,000

Virtual Racing

The maximum payment to any one client in respect of any one day's virtual Racing bets for which all selections are covered in full by SIS, TRP and VIP Betting Channel is £2,000. This applies to both singles and accumulators and any bets which contain a virtual racing selection. This applies to all betting channels, In shop, text and Telephone.

Soccer / Football

The maximum that can be won on any bet including a football selection is £50,000 including ante-post.

Golf

The maximum that can be won on any bet including a golf selection/event is £50,000

G.A.A

The maximum that can be won on any bet including a G.A.A selection/event is £50,000

US Sports

The maximum that can be won on any bet including a US Sport Selection/Event is £20,000

Other sports

Any bet which includes a sport selection (other than stated above) will be subject to a maximum payment of £20,000. Should multiple sports be combined the lower limit shall always apply.

Non Sport Events excluding Lottery

Any bet which includes a selection for non-sport/racing event such as a song contest, political contest, election etc. will be subject to a maximum payment of £25,000

Lotteries/ 49s

The maximum payout to any one client, group/ syndicate of customers, for betting on the Irish Lottery, Monday Millions, Daily Millions, Daily 49's and any other numbers game is £20,000.
